- Respect for the dignity
  - Autonomy / free informed decisions
  - Privacy Confidentiality of personal data
  - Protection of vulnerable persons
- Optimization of risk/benefit / all health interventions (beneficence non maleficence)
- Justice
  - Equity in access to care and treatment
  - Absence of discrimination (gender, age, ethnicity, etc.)
