RESPECT FOR INDIVIDUALS



- **Respect for the dignity**
 - Autonomy / free informed decisions
 - Privacy – Confidentiality of personal data
 - Protection of vulnerable persons
- **Optimization of risk/benefit /** all health interventions (beneficence - non maleficence)
- **Justice**
 - Equity in access to care and treatment
 - Absence of discrimination (gender, age, ethnicity, etc.)
